

WHO CAN HELP?... HERE ARE SOME OF OUR 2022 HELPERS:

Food Pantry Gardens provide opportunities for individuals and groups from both CUMC and the surrounding community to be the hands and feet of Christ. All season, a handful of dedicated gardeners regularly watered, tended, de-bugged and harvested.

- CUMC Preschool class pulled weeds, harvested tomatoes, and seeded fall crops.
- CHS Softball teams prepared beds, harvested herbs, and planted vegetables.
- Two different Scout Troops pulled weeds, moved mulch, and harvested beans.
- CUMC's new member class, our high school youth group, and summer mission camp kids, all worked hard moving soil and mulch, prepping beds, and pulling weeds.
- 5th grade kids from the St. Marks UMC Missions Camp spent a day here learning and serving.
