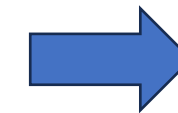

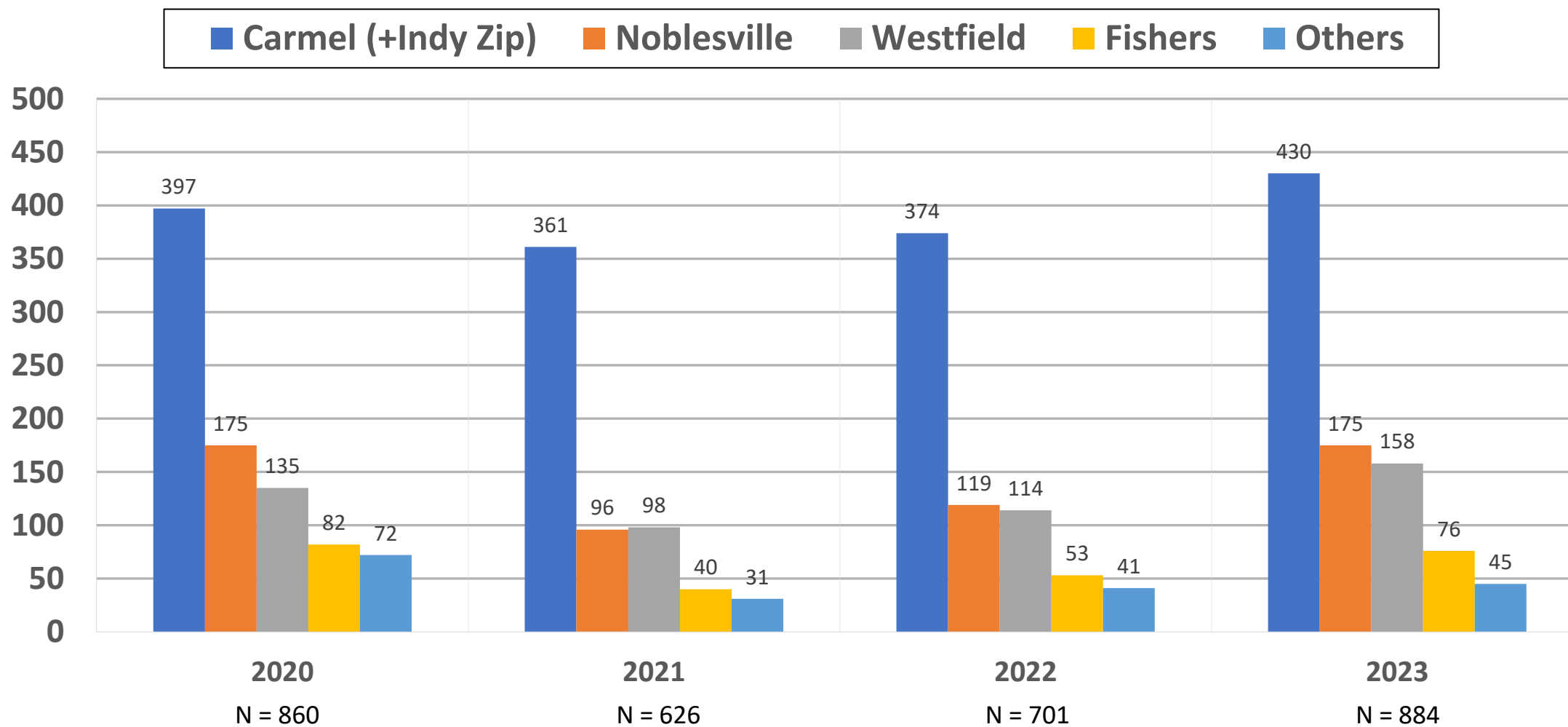

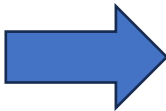

Number of Unique Addresses Per Zip Code at CUMC Food Pantry (2020-23)



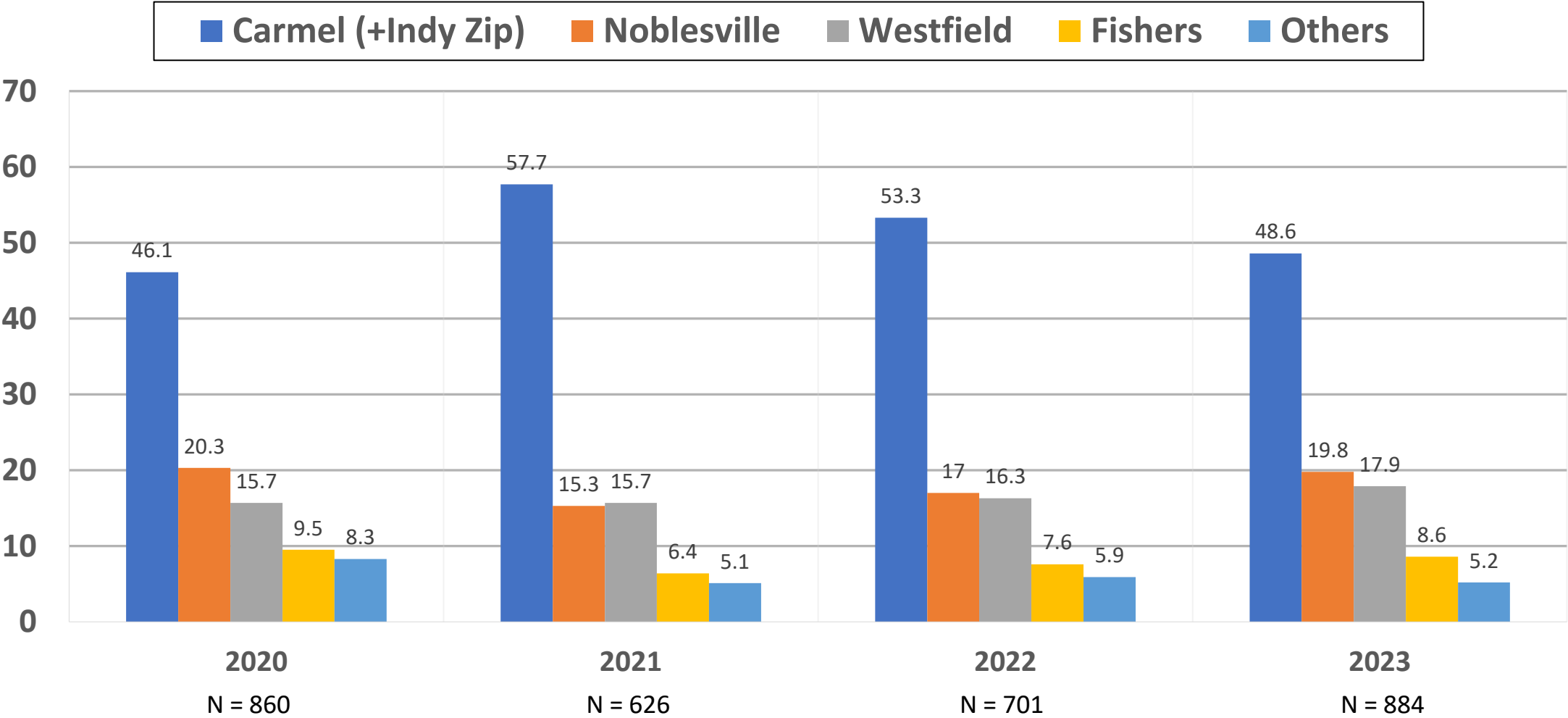

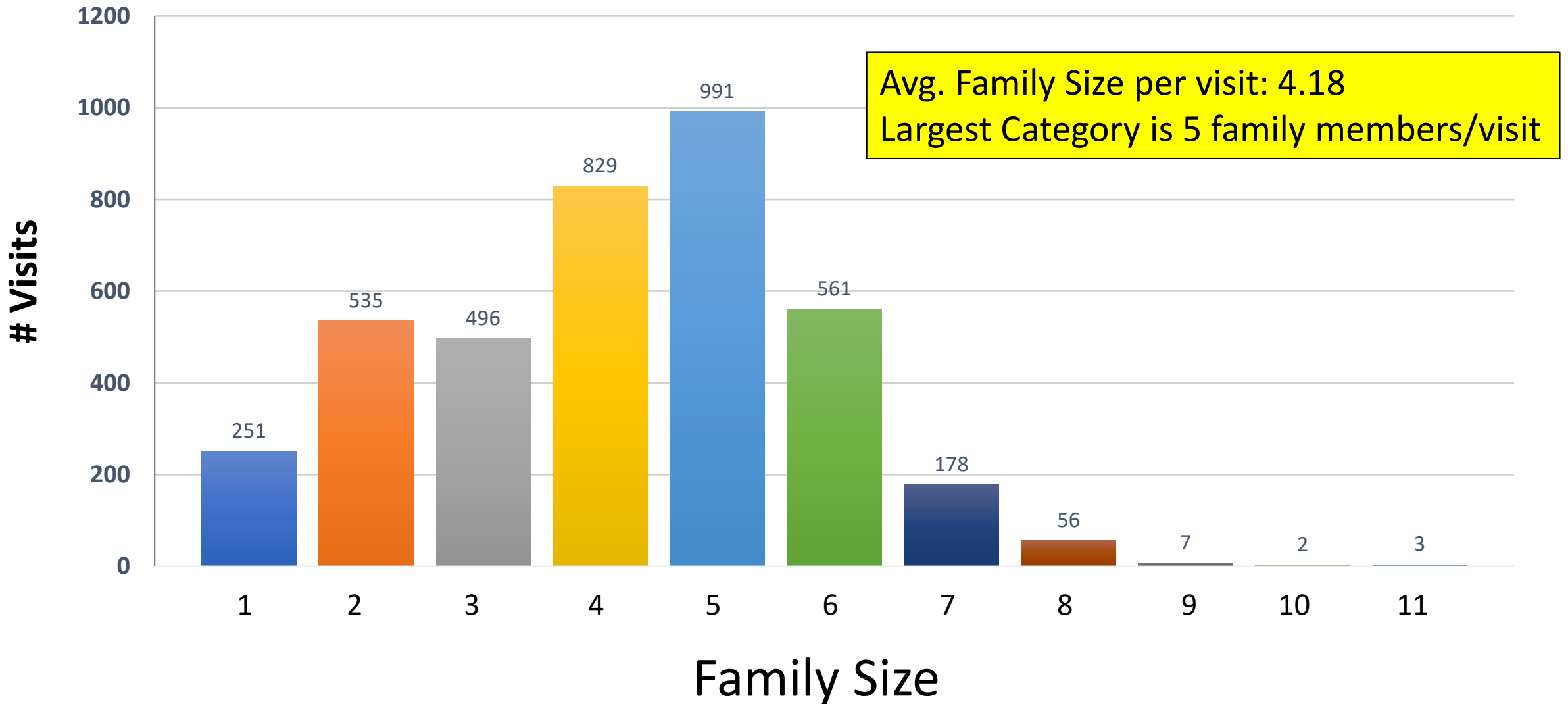
% Distribution of Unique Addresses Per Zip Code at CUMC Food Pantry (2020-23)

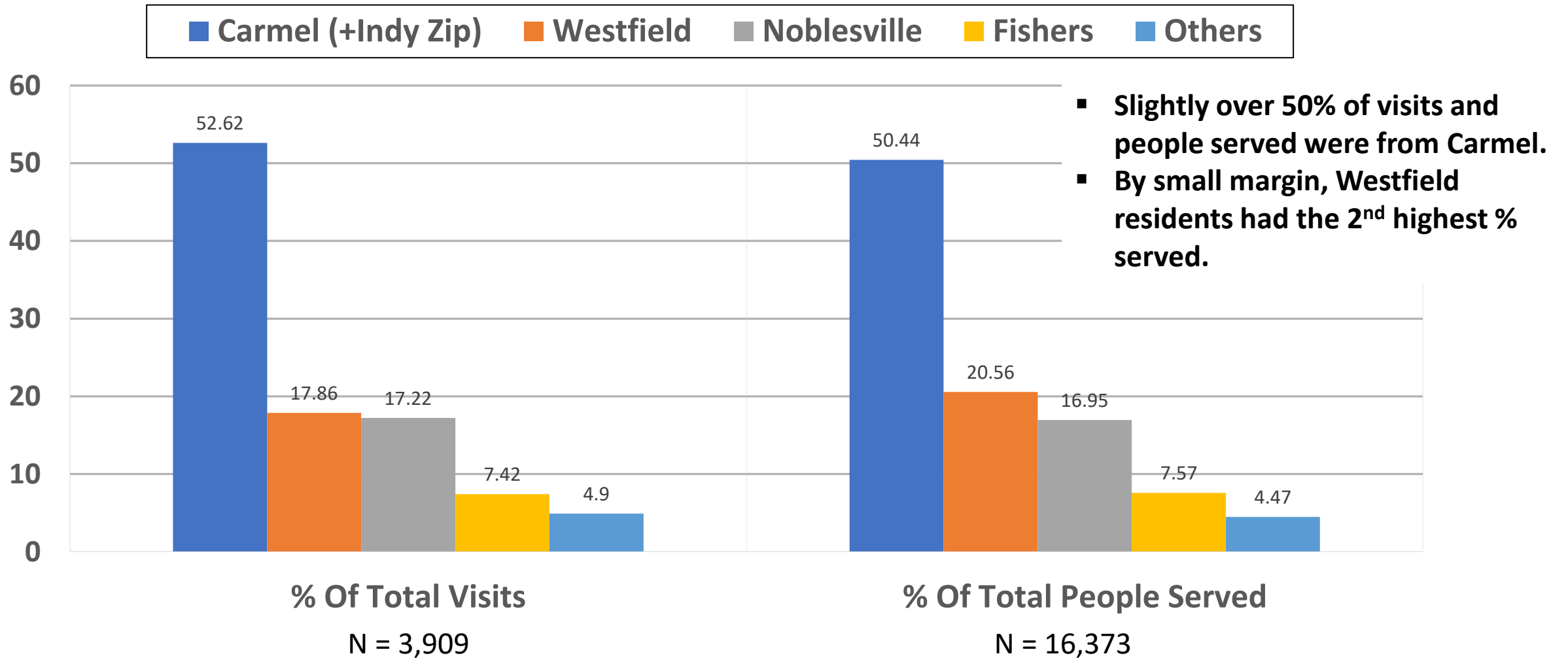

Distribution of Family Sizes for Each CUMC Food Pantry Visit (2023)

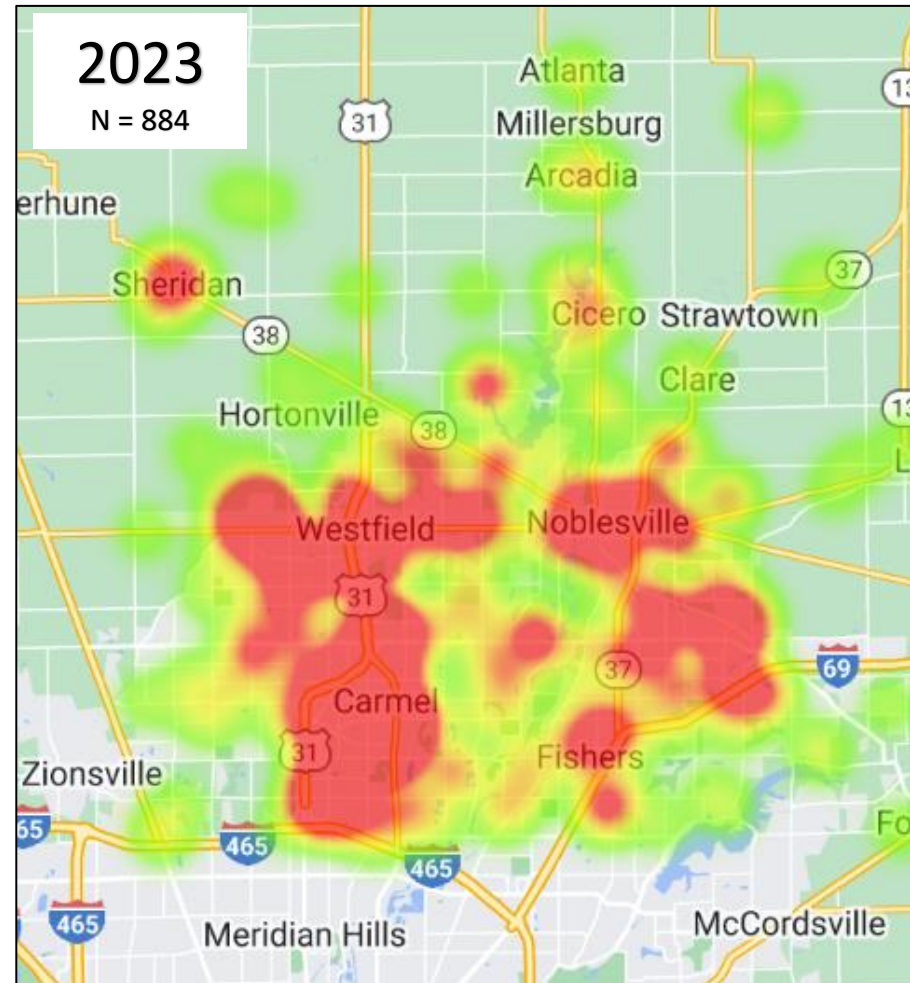
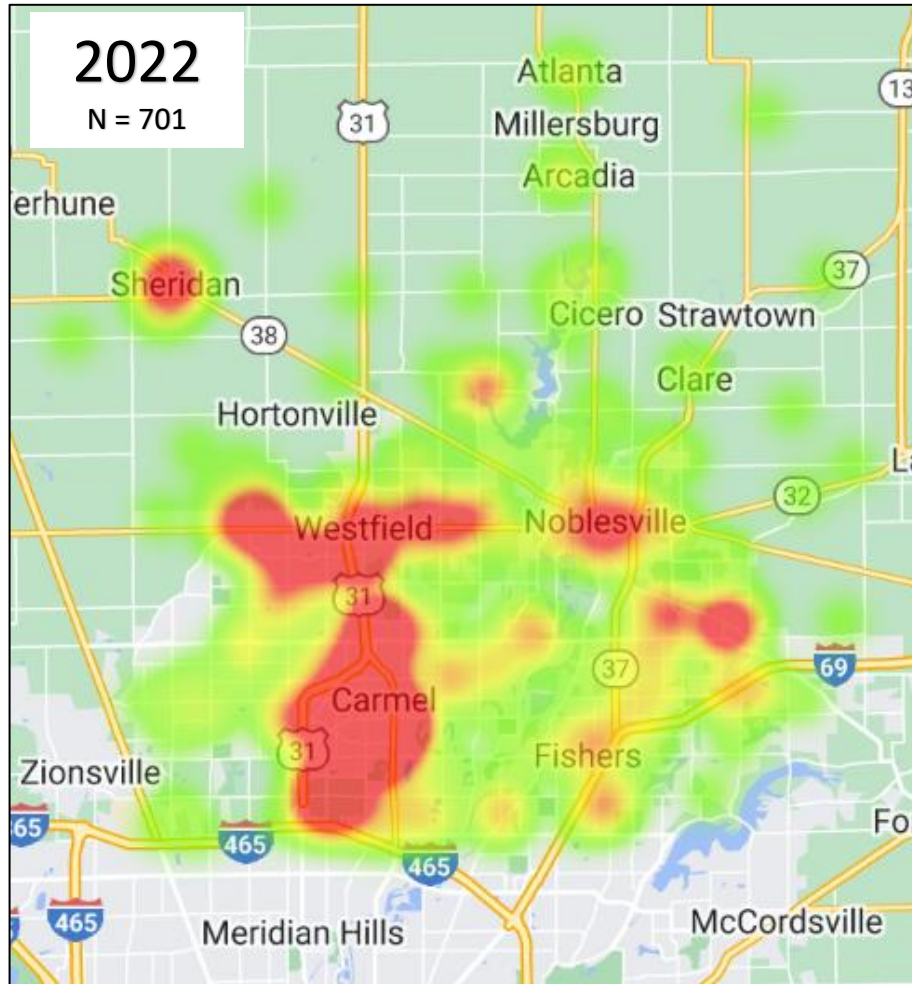

“Heat Map” of CUMC Food Pantry Customer Addresses (2022-2023)

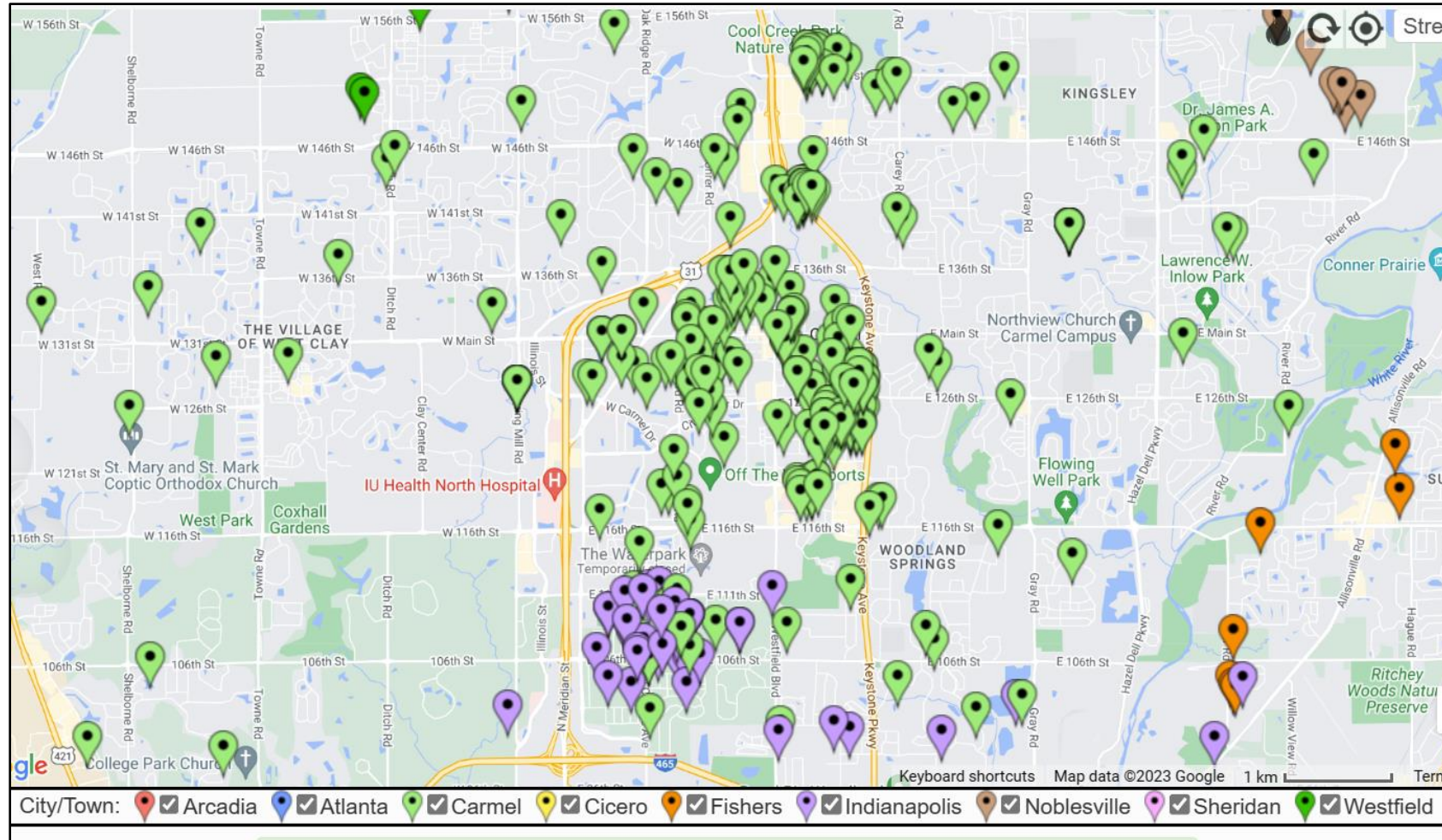

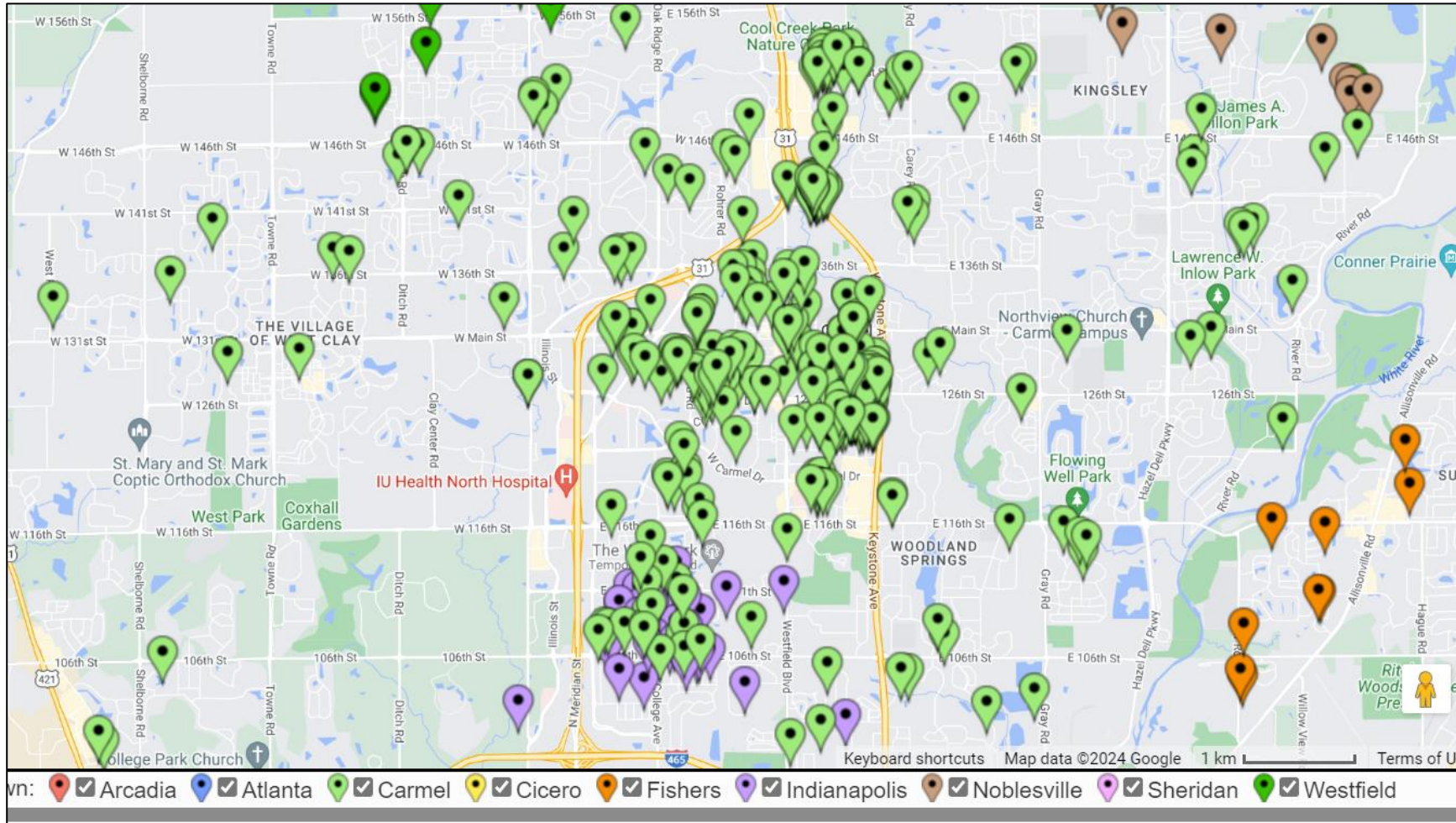
Red areas indicates highest density of FP customer addresses

Highest density of Carmel FP customers were located in central area of city limits (between Meridian and Keystone).

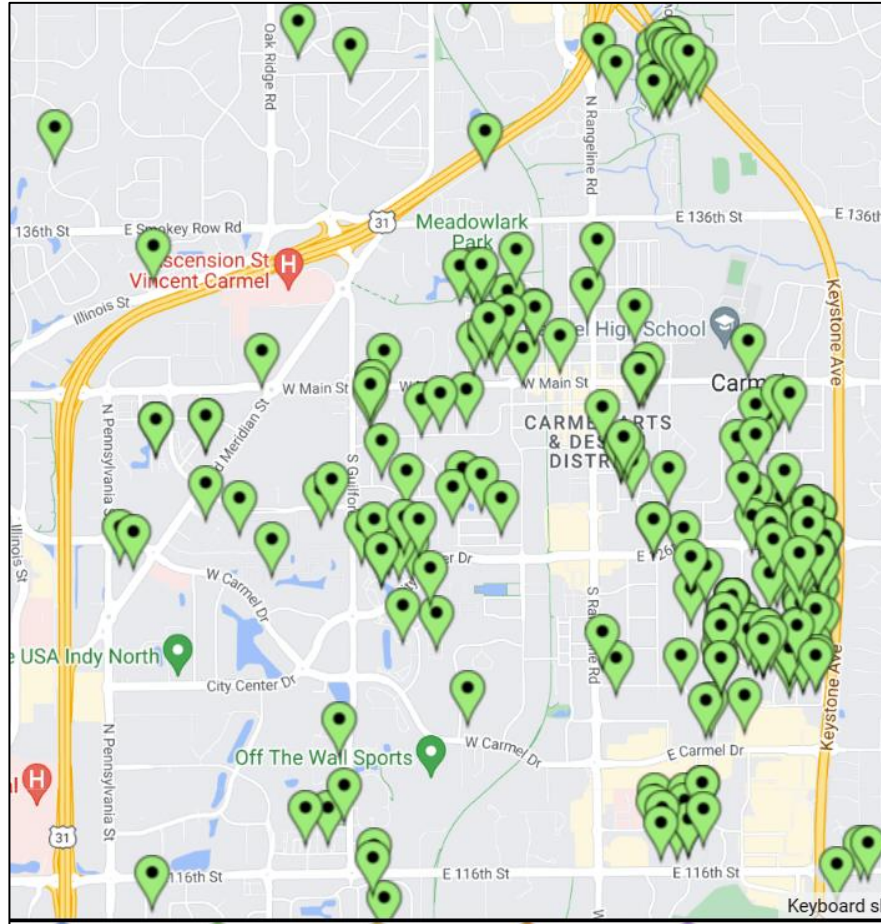
“Pinned” Addresses of FP Customers in Carmel: 2023



Highest density of Carmel FP customers are still located in center of city limits.

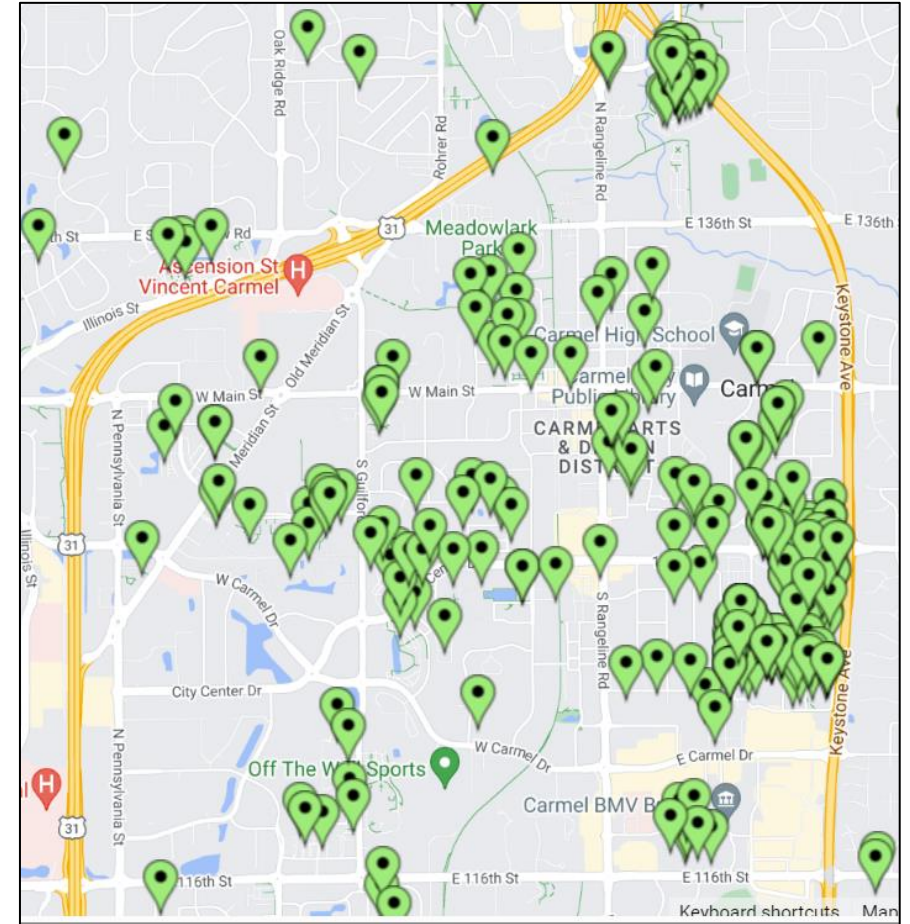
“Pinned” Addresses of FP Customers in North-Central Carmel (2022-23)

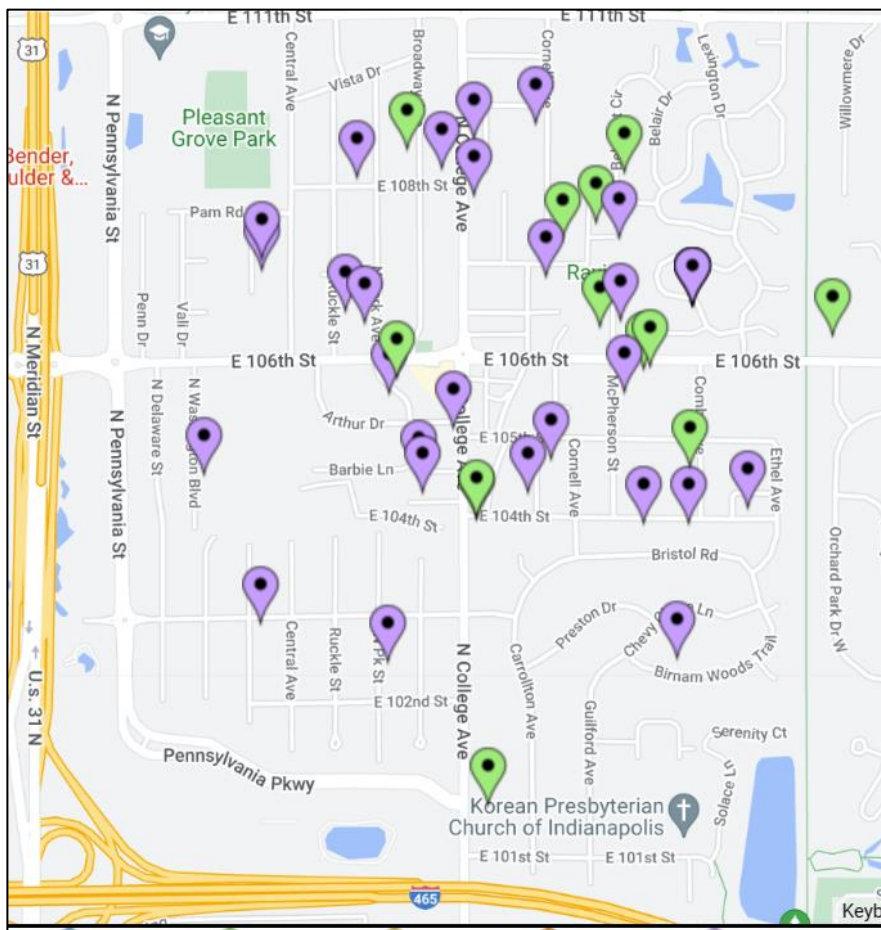

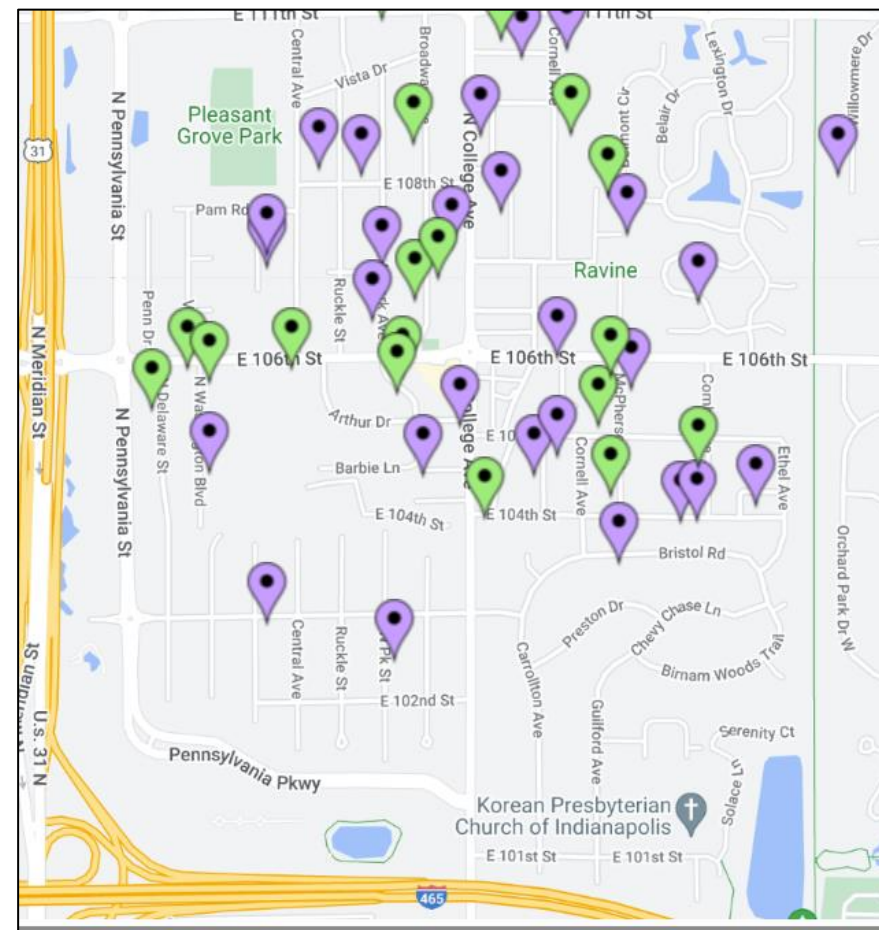

Home Place/Orchard Park

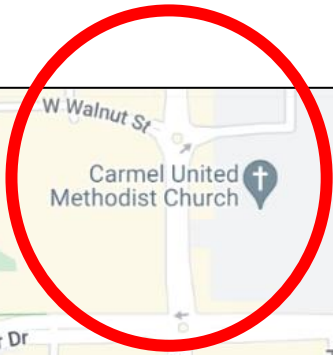

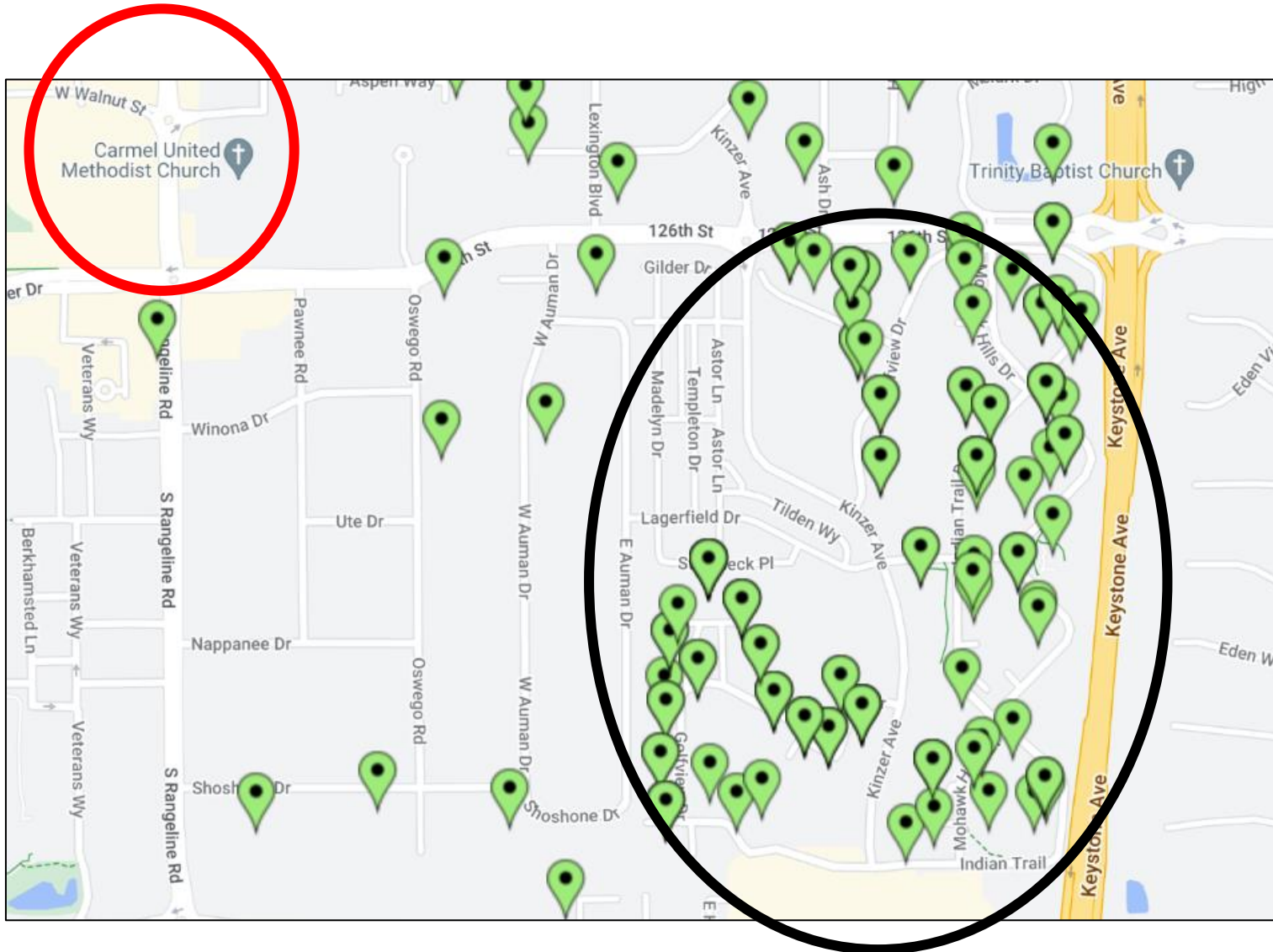

2023 CUMC FP Summary

- 20.7% increase in “unique addresses” served from 2022 to 2023
- Carmel remain highest % of unique addresses served, followed by Noblesville and Westfield.
- Average family size across all visits is 4.18 members per visit, with 5 family members per visit the most common category.
- 3,909 total visits to FP in 2023, with 16,373 people served.
- Slightly over 50% of visits and people served were from Carmel. By small margin, Westfield residents had the 2nd highest % served.
- Highest density of Carmel FP customers were located in central area of city limits (between Meridian and Keystone).
- Many customers of CUMC FP continue to live in close proximity to our church.
